COVID19 : Advisory for Indian Nationals

In view of the total lockdown in India, as announced by the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Government of India's recent travel advisory prohibiting all passengers from Malaysia, including Indian Nationals, from travelling to India **from 17 March 2020 has been now extended upto 14 April 2020.**

Kindly note that these restrictions are temporary in nature and are being periodically reviewed at the high levels in GOI. Concurrently, the Government of Malaysia has **extended the Movement Control Order (MCO) effective 18 March 2020 till 14 April 2020.**

Since no flights will be operating from Malaysia to India and in view of the prevailing COVID-19 situation across the world, including India and Malaysia, all Indian Nationals in Malaysia, resident or visitors, are requested:-

- (i) **Follow the directives of Malaysian Government** with regard to the MCO.
- (ii) To **stay indoors, stay safe and maintain social distancing.**
- (iii) **Not to go to the Airport** till the Government of India restrictions are in effect in order to **prevent avoidable exposure to COVID19 infection.**

Government of Malaysia has given exemption to all foreigners whose pass has expired during the MCO period only.
