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PRESS RELEASE

1. At the invitation of H.E. Dato Seri' Anwar Ibrahim, Prime Minister of Malaysia, Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi virtually attended the 22nd ASEAN (Association of South East Asian Nations) - India Summit on 26 October, 2025. Prime Minister Narendra Modi and ASEAN leaders jointly assessed developments in ASEAN-India relations and considered measures for enhancing the Comprehensive Strategic Partnership.

2. On the sidelines of the ASEAN-India Summit and other meetings, External Affairs Minister Dr. S. Jaishankar had a meeting with Minister of Foreign Affairs of Malaysia H.E. Mr Mohamad Hasan.

3. The following agreements have been reached recently as part of the continuing collaboration between India and Malaysia in various sectors:

i. MoU between IIT Madras Global and Malaysia's Advanced Semiconductor Academy of Malaysia (ASEM) which focuses on the twin initiatives of a) launching graduate skilling program in Computer Architecture and RISC-V Design to advance Malaysian engineers' semiconductor skills and b) Semester Exchange and Joint Certificate Programme in collaboration with the University of Selangor to co-develop an enhanced Electrical and Electronic Engineering curriculum. Subsequently, as a follow-up to the signing of the MoU, IIT Madras Global also participated in the launching ceremony of the Second IC Design Park on 6 November 2025 in Cyberjaya presided over by Hon'ble Prime Minister of Malaysia.

ii. MoU between National Small Industries Corporation and SME Corp of Malaysia to strengthen, promote and develop cooperation and collaboration in the field of entrepreneurship development and business exchanges between the two countries

iii. MoU between Central Council for Research in Homeopathy and University of Cyberjaya on furthering academic collaboration in Homeopathy.
