## DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS FOR OCI CARD APPLICATION

This is to bring attention to the procedure for applying for the Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) card outlined on the website of the High Commission of India in Kuala Lumpur (https://hcikl.gov.in/). In this regard, kindly note the following modification in the list of documents required to be submitted as proof of Indian origin:

- a) The extract of Malaysian Identity Card (IC) mentioning the personal particulars of the applicant or ancestor (as the case may be), including the place of birth, will be accepted as proof of Indian origin. The extracted document must be attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Government of Malaysia.
- 2. The High Commission of India in Kuala Lumpur reserves the right to call for additional supporting document as and when deemed fit.
- 3. Applicants desirous of applying for OCI cards are requested to adhere to the procedure and guidelines mentioned on the Mission's website. Kindly note that documents issued by foreign governments need to be attested either by the concerned Ministry of Foreign Affairs or by the respective Embassy/Consulate.
