**Special Reservation of seats to Foreign Students for admission in Under-Graduate and Post-Graduate courses of Indian Maritime University, Chennai**

The Indian Maritime University, Chennai is a premier Central University in India. The charter of the university is to promote and achieve excellence in areas of maritime studies, training, research and extension with focus on emerging areas like Oceanography, Maritime History, Maritime Laws, Maritime Security, Search and Rescue, Transportation of Dangerous Cargo, Environmental Studies and other related fields.

- vii. Master of Technology (Dredging and Harbour Engineering)
- viii. Master of Technology (Maritime Technology)
- ix. MBA (Port & Shipping Management)
- x. MBA (International Transportation & Logistics Management)

The University is offering admission to Foreign Nationals / Persons of Indian Origin (PIOs) / Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) / Non-Resident Indians (NRIs) for its UG and PG courses under the Direct Admission of Students Abroad (DASA) scheme <[www.dasanit.org](http://www.dasanit.org)>. The Indian diaspora candidates i.e. NRIs / PIOs / OCI, that get admission under the DASA scheme can also apply for obtaining 75% scholarship from the Government of India, under the 'Scholarship Programme for Diaspora Children' (SPDC).
