1. As-Is Basis: The vehicle is offered for sale strictly on an "as-is, where-is" basis. The seller makes no explicit or implied warranties regarding the mechanical, structural, or cosmetic condition of the vehicle once finalized.

2. Deposit Forfeiture: If the highest bid is formally accepted and the bidder fails to settle the remaining 90% balance within 3 working days, the 10% advance deposit will be forfeited in full to the seller.

3. Refund of Deposits: Deposits submitted by unsuccessful bidders will be returned or refunded in full within 3 working days following the closing or final award of the bidding process.

4. Duties and Taxes: In addition to the bid amount, there is an additional cost on import duty payable to the Royal Malaysian Customs Department. All transfer related charges on registration, applicable taxes incl. customs duty etc. shall be borne by the buyer.

VEHICLE PURCHASE BIDDING – OFFICIAL FAQ

1. Vehicle Condition & Inspection

Q: What is the current mileage of the vehicle?

A: The current mileage is approximately between 210,000 km and 220,000 km.

Q: Are there any past major accidents, mechanical faults, or body damage on this vehicle?

A: No. The vehicle has no history of major accidents, structural faults, mechanical errors, or body damage.

Q: Can I arrange to inspect the vehicle or bring a mechanic before putting in my bid?

A: Yes, viewing can easily be arranged upon request. Interested individuals are welcome to inspect the vehicle at the High Commission of India office:

2. Bidding Timeline & Balance Payment

Q: Once the bidding window closes, when and how will the bids be processed?

A: Following the close of the bidding window, all submitted bids will be formally opened on the very next working day.

Q: If I win the bid, how long do I have to pay the remaining 90% balance?

A: The successful bidder is required to settle the remaining 90% balance within 3 working days of being notified.

3. Deposit Refunds for Unsuccessful Bidders

Q: If my bid is unsuccessful, how and when will my 10% advance deposit be returned?

A:

- For Cheques / Bank Drafts: We will return your original physical cheque or bank draft directly to you.
- For Bank Transfers: The funds will be refunded back to your bank account within 3 working days after the bids are opened.

4. Post-Bid Logistics, Customs & Legalities

Q: Since this is an official vehicle, how will the Puspakom inspection and JPJ ownership transfer be managed?

A: We will handle getting the official Puspakom inspection completed. Once the necessary official sales approvals are obtained from the Malaysian government, we will fully assist you with the JPJ ownership transfer process.

Q: Are there additional costs like customs duties, and who pays for them?

A: Yes. In addition to your winning bid amount, there is an import duty of RM 46,031.82/-, payable to the Royal Malaysian Customs Department. All registration charges, ownership transfer fees etc., payable to JPJ, must be fully borne by the buyer.

Q: When can I physically pick up the vehicle after paying in full?

A: Vehicle pickup will take place directly from the High Commission approximately 4 weeks after full payment is made. This timeline allows our office to secure all necessary official government clearances and approvals required to finalize the sale. If the office is not able to obtain necessary approvals to conduct the sale, the sale will be cancelled, and total amount shall be refunded in full.
